## **Divine Mercy**

*Prepare for Easter and Divine Mercy Sunday on April 11. Go to Confession and receive Holy Communion. Our Lord gave us many words of comfort that could ease the fears of those who would be reluctant to enter into the Sacrament of Confession. Jesus said to St Faustina, "When you approach the confessional, know this, that I Myself am waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest, but I Myself act in your soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of mercy (Diary 1602). Make your confession before Me. The person of the priest is, for Me, only a screen. Never analyze what sort of a priest it is that I am making use of; open your soul in confession as you would to Me, and I will fill it with My light" (St Faustina's Diary 1725).
