Dear Families,

The classes walked to the movie, Oceans, today. It was a wonderful site to see them all walking together, younger ones with older ones and eighth grade picking up the rear of the line. The temperature was cool but great for walking. So... the trip home was amazing! THANK YOU PARENTS! You are the world's best! Our thanks go out to Sgt. Green and the Yuba City Police Department for their help and organization getting our student across the highway and with getting the students into the cars. The walkers turned into passengers, followed directions with precision and were great about the changes. Of course, by the time everyone was back and ready for prayer before meal we had sunshine and big puddles.

Please follow these few suggestions and rules:

- Please do not allow soda in student lunches, this is not a good habit, water is best.
- In our handbook the style of the tight-tight skinny jeans is not a free dress option (even if it is in-style). This is for male and female students.
- Cell phones are a privilege at school during the total school time – 7 am to 6 pm. Morning and afternoon extension, sports teams and coaches, tutoring and teachers as well as the office are places where cell phones are under the control of an adult. Students are able to use their phone after asking for permission to use the phone and only where the lead adult allows the phone to be used.
- We are a closed campus. Students are not to leave campus on their own (or in a group without an adult); going for food across the street is not allowed after school before practice starts. Students are to sign in at extension unless they are with the coach or other adult at the time between the school bell at 3:05 and the start of their after school activity. If special arrangements have been made between a teacher and a parent, please follow them. Morning procedures, before 7:45, are that students drop off their backpack at their classroom then proceed to the extension room to check in. After 7:45, students drop their backpack at the classroom then proceed to the playground. Students are not to hang out in the hallway, parking lot, church building or other buildings.

We are working on putting together a summer care program for the school age students. Our pre-school will have a program. Preschool costs are the same as the rest of the school year. Details of the summer program and the school registration information will be out in the next newsletter. We will have an early bird registration discount, part of the registration will be handled on line through Option C and we are trying to hold costs so that there is the smallest of increases in tuition. Our budget is in the final stages of approval with the final decision happening on May 6th.
