

St. Isidore Catholic School is now enrolling for the 2009-2010 year.

There are places available for students in all grades, pre-school through 8<sup>th</sup>. The school offers a full curriculum in a faith-based environment, and students *do not* have to be Catholic to enroll. In fact, the school is open for enrollment by students of all religious, cultural and ethnic backgrounds and does not discriminate in its application, admission or enrollment process. The school recognizes and respects all faith traditions and asks only that its non-Catholic students respect the school's Catholic tradition.

Total preschool through 8th grade enrollment for the 2008-2009 year was 218, with a student-teacher ratio of around 20 to 1. We have one class at each grade level, taught by experienced, credentialed teachers.
