TIME

CONTENT

- 1) Give an overview of your experiment.
- 2) You may use note cards but don't read them.
- 3) Be ready to answer questions.

PRACTICE

POSTURE

- 1) Make good eye contact and don't talk to or read from your display board.
- 2) Speak loudly, clearly, and confidently.
- 3) Stand up straight and don't swing back and forth or wiggle around.
