Science Fair—6th Grade

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Science Fair is held each year at the end of January in conjunction with Catholic Schools Week. The 6th grade students are assigned and will complete a Science Fair experiment in class with a partner.

After the experiment is done, your student will get information on how to write the report, make a display, and make an oral presentation. Each student will need to write his or her own report; however they will make a display and oral presentation with their partner.

The written report & display are due in the Parish Hall on Monday morning, February 1, 2010. The projects are to be dropped off from 7:30-8:00 am. Judging will take place Tuesday afternoon and the projects will be on display for Open House, Wednesday evening February 3. Oral presentations will be made during this week. The projects are to go home Friday afternoon at the end of school.

The students will be learning about making investigations and completing reports in class. There are a lot of resources to help with the science fair outside of school, however. For instance, The Sutter County library has many books dealing with science experiments in the Children's section. Many resources can be found on the internet by keying in "middle school science fair". Keep in mind that your student will need a minimum of 3 resources for their report.
