Re: New Safe Environment Training for Employees and Volunteers

Diocesan safe environment guidelines state that, **in addition** to fingerprinting, all clergy, diocesan employees, and volunteers who work with children, are required to complete a child abuse prevention and diocesan policy training program once every 3 years.

The *Shield the Vulnerable* program is available in both English and Spanish and takes approximately one hour to complete online. It can be accessed by any computer and can be completed in stages as time permits.

### **Who needs to take the training?**

- All Diocesan/School employees who completed the previous training prior to 2006.
- All School volunteers, who have not been trained through their Parish or who completed the previous training prior to 2006
